CALL FOR PROPOSALS DEADLINE EXTENDED

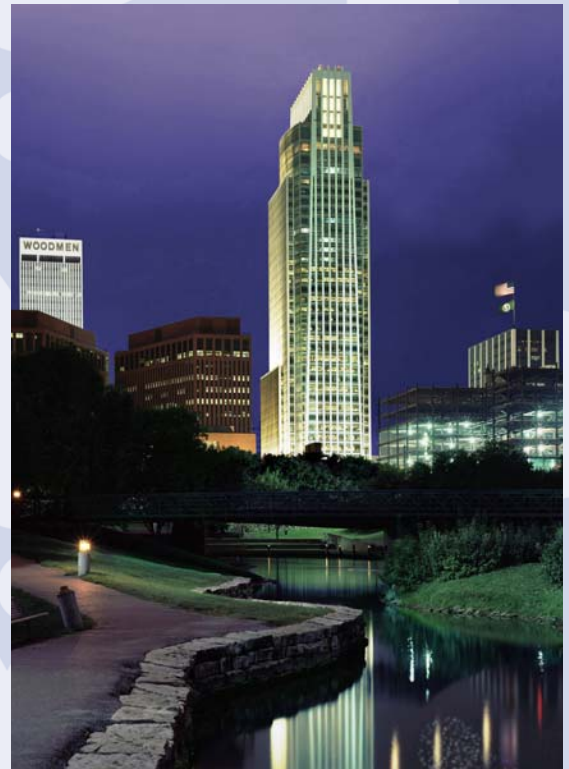
***Presentation Proposal Submissions

The deadline to submit presentation proposals for the U.S. Department of Education's 21st Annual National Meeting on Alcohol and Other Drug Abuse and Violence Prevention in Higher Education has been extended to **MONDAY, MAY 21, 2007**. Submissions can be made online at www.higheredcenter.org/natl/2007. This year's meeting takes place at the DoubleTree Hotel and Conference Center in Omaha, Nebraska, October 18-21, 2007.

The theme of this year's National Meeting is **Harvesting Ideas for Safe and Healthy Campuses: Effective Strategies Built on Research and Practice**. The committee is considering proposals primarily for workshops and poster sessions and will consider all proposals that address the following review criteria: consistency with conference theme, theoretical basis or context, replicability and adaptability across settings, and evidence of lessons learned.

If you plan to submit a proposal, please keep in mind...

We will review no more than two proposals per lead presenter and will not consider proposals where it appears that the focus of the session is primarily on promoting a specific commercial product.
