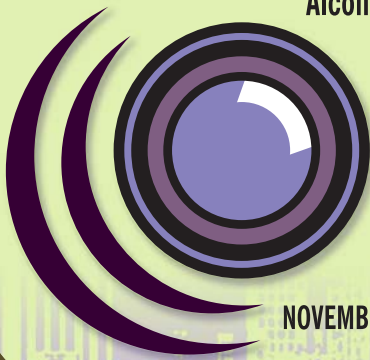

Based on the nature of your request and staff availability, we will assign you to an appointment with a Center staff member and notify you of your meeting time.
