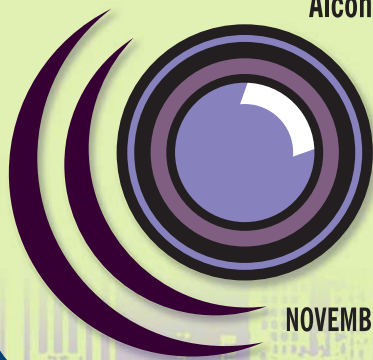

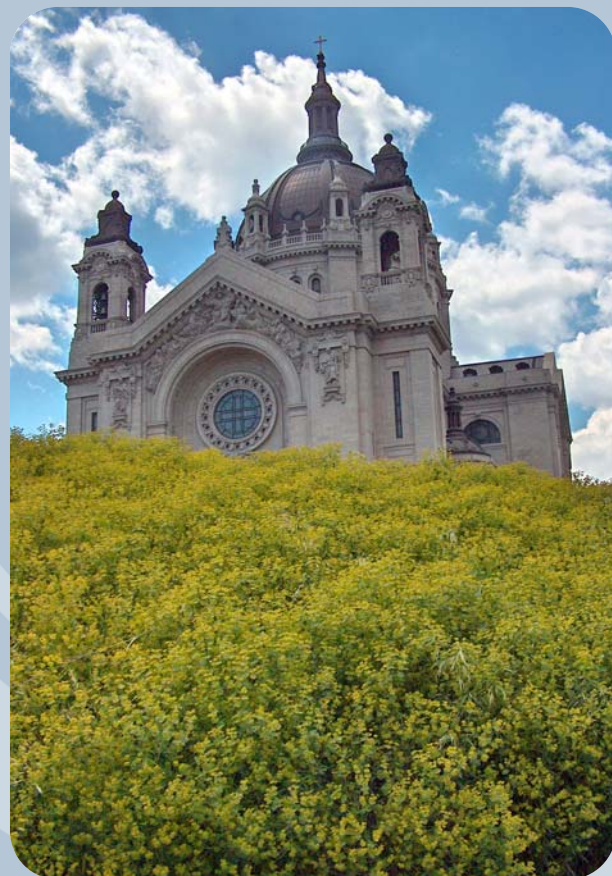


## Summer Announcement
